

## **NEW SARS POWER OF ATTORNEY (POA) TEMPLATE**

SARS has replaced the Power of Attorney (POA) template with two new templates. The two new templates can be used as follows:

- General Power of Attorney Form online POA template: for completion and print.
   Please note all fields must be completed.
- General Power of Attorney Manual you can print a blank copy and complete by hand.

The POA is valid for two years and SARS requires that the original POA be produced on every visit to the SARS branch i.e. the original POA which was agreed to and signed by you and the taxpayer during your initial engagement. A new POA must be entered into after the two year validity period has expired. In the event that your clerk or secretary acts on your behalf, a letter confirming that he/she has authority together with his/her original identity document/passport is required in addition to the required POA.

The new POA template is also applicable to the change of banking details. SARS will only accept a POA in the following exceptional circumstances:

- Any estate due to death or sequestration
- Taxpayer who is incapacitated / terminally ill/ imprisoned
- Taxpayer who is a non-resident (emigrant, expatriate, foreigner and temporarily outside the Republic)
- Taxpayer who is a minor child.

Only a tax practitioner can change taxpayer banking details in the above circumstances. This means that the authority to change banking details assigned to the tax practitioner by the taxpayer, cannot be delegated to a subordinate. The two year validity period does not apply to the change of banking details and a new POA is required in every instance where the tax practitioner is required to change taxpayer banking details in exceptional circumstances.
